The Showbag Pavilion is open from 9.30am-9.30pm. Evening Entertainment concludes at 8.45pm. Kids carnival closes late, while Carnival on Australia Avenue closes at 9.30pm.

## Parking

Parking at Sydney Olympic Park will be in high demand during the Sydney Royal Easter Show and car parks are likely to reach capacity on weekends and public holidays.
